Course Description: July 17th & 18th NPCA certifications (attendance at certifications is optional as needed by each team) Monday-July 17th-Narcotics & EOD; Tuesday-July 18th-Patrol. Wednesday, July 19th will include ALECA meeting followed by 3 hour lecture on Officer Safety Tactics related to surveillance and related traffic stops. The lecture will be provided by Marc Fleischmann, a 37 year veteran of LAPD with majority of those years spent with the LAPD SIS Unit. Marc is currently employed as a special investigator for the Orange County District Attorney's Office. Following the lecture, handlers will break out to participate in 8 Reality Based, live scenarios, at various locations throughout Payson. Thursday, July 20th will begin in the evening with 8 more reality-based scenarios. Each scenario will be unique and will challenge handlers decision making and tactics related to patrol work and detection.
